He has been Professor of the Laboratory of Drug Metabolism and Pharmacokinetics at Showa Pharmaceutical University, Tokyo, Japan, since 2005. He received his PhD from Osaka University in Japan and was trained at Vanderbilt University, TN, USA, in 1994. He was a scientist at Osaka Prefectural Institute of Public Health and an Associate Professor at Kanazawa University (1998) and Hokkaido University (2001). He has authored over 400 publications and is a recipient of the JSSX Award as well as being a JSSX Fellow. He is the current JSSX President (2017-2019), a co-chair of the joint Hawaii meeting of 35th JSSX and 23rd ISSX (2020), and a member of several editorial committees.
